**OPTIONAL SIGHTSEEING DAY TOURS**

Hong Kong Island Tour

Time: 08:30-13:30 (Daily)

Pick up: Hotel Lobby

*This tour is a must for foreign visitors. It includes a visit to Victoria Peak for a panoramic splendor view of the city and Stanley Market which is famous for bargain shopping. It then returns along the coastal line via Repulse Bay and Deep Water Bay to Aberdeen, the floating village for fishermen (sampan ride at Aberdeen will be at optional cost). A stop at a local jewellery factory near Aberdeen offers a chance to look at the fine art and craftsmanship that has made Hong Kong famous in Asia.*

Land Between - New Territories Tour

Time: 08:30-12:30 (Daily)

Pick-up: City Hall Lower Block (facing Victoria Harbour)

*The New Territories is an enormously diverse suburban area full of contrasts to the cosmopolitan city center. More than a century ago, this area was entirely rural. Today, the area still abounds in rural beauty. Yet modern times have made their mark. The Land Between stands both as a gentle reminder of Hong Kong past as well as a symbol of its hopes and plans for the future. Stops will be made at Yuan Yuan Institute, Tai Mo Shan, Luk Keng, Sam Mun Tsai Fishing Village.*

New Lantau Island Tour

Time: 08:45 – 15:45 (Daily except Sundays & Holidays)

Pick-up : Hotel Lobby

*Explore Hong Kong's largest outlying island just an hour's ferry ride away from Hong Kong Island. The morning begins with a ferry trip from Central. Cruise through Victoria Harbour and past islands in the outer harbour to Mui Wo (Silver Mine Bay) on Lantau Island. From here, a tour bus takes you past the two-kilometre long, white sands of Cheung Sha Beach and over the Shek Pik Reservoir dam. Visit the Tanka boat people's stilt-house fishing village at Tai O, then visit the famous Po Lin Monastery and view the world's tallest seated, outdoor bronze Buddha. The tour includes a vegetarian lunch prepared by the monks at the monastery.*

Macau Day Tour with Lunch

Time: 08:45-17:45 (Daily)

Pick-up: Hotel Lobby

*A 75 minute Jetfoil, Turbocat or Catamaran ride brings you to Macau with visits to Kum Yam Temple, up to Penha Hill for a magnificent view of the city, Barrier Gate at the border between Macau and China and the Ruins of St. Paul Cathedral. A western lunch will be served and followed by free time to visit the famous Casino.*

Shenzhen City Tour + China Folk Culture Villages

Time: 06:45-17:45 (Daily)

Pick-up: Hotel Lobby

*In the morning, pick up from the designated hotel.*

*– Catch the first-class train to Shenzhen*

*–Take a brief city tour and discover how Shenzhen is developing*

*–Visit an exhibition of the famous Terra-cotta Warriors & Horse.*

*–After lunch, visit China Folk Culture Villages to meet the ethnic minorities and their traditional dwellings.*

*Continue to see Splendid China to observe the extraordinary collection of miniature replicas of China best lovely attractions. Afterwards, return to Hong Kong by first class train. Tours end at Tsimshatsui Districts.*
